

WHAT IS FOOD WASTE?

Food waste can be of animal or plant origin and is food material that has been discarded, is unable to be used, or has been deemed unfit for human consumption.

WHO PRODUCES IT?

The origins of food waste are varied, with waste occurring at all stages of the food supply chain. Producers of food waste include supermarkets, retailers, farmers, restaurants, processing plants and consumers.

HOW WE MANAGE IT

At Novus Environmental, we understand that food waste needs to be removed and disposed of quickly. Our specialised fleet allows us to offer a swift and flexible solution, ensuring that any food waste is taken away and dealt with efficiently.

Upon receipt, we recycle and treat food waste in the most appropriate manner. For example, contaminated meat is incinerated, whilst vegetables and fruit can be sent for Anaerobic Digestion.

OFFENSIVE WASTE

WHAT IS OFFENSIVE WASTE?

Offensive waste is non-infectious waste that is unpleasant and offends the senses:

- Human healthcare: EWC 18 01 04- Animal healthcare: EWC 18 02 03

- Non-healthcare: EWC 20 01 99

Provided the waste is appropriately segregated, contained and properly handled, the residual health risk is considered low.

WHO PRODUCES IT?

It is produced in a variety of commercial premises, such as night clubs, shopping malls, offices and factories. It is also produced by human and animal healthcare providers, hospitals, nursing homes and hospices, veterinary practices and zoological institutes.

HOW WE MANAGE IT



Our fully licenced waste management service provides you with the assurance that your offensive waste is handled, transported, and treated in accordance with the Department of Health guide: HTM 07:01 Safe Management of Healthcare Waste, for peace of mind.

WASTE TO ENERGY (WTE)

Our disposal routes for PPE and offensive waste include Waste to Energy where the waste is sterilised and or shredded and processed through a WtE facility.





WHAT IS ANIMAL BY-PRODUCT WASTE?

Animal By-Products (also known as ABPs) are defined as entire bodies, parts of animals, products of animal origin or other products obtained from animals that are deemed unfit or not intended for human consumption.

ABPs are segregated into three categories, determining their disposal method:

Category 1 is the highest risk material consisting mainly of animal remains that are considered most likely to carry a disease and are a Transmissible spongiform encephalopathies (TSE).

Category 2 is also deemed high risk material and includes fallen stock, manure and digestive tract content. It is also the Category for ABPs not defined as either Category 1 or Category 3 material.

Category 3 is low risk material. It includes animal parts that are not intended for human consumption. This category also includes former foodstuffs and catering waste.

WHO PRODUCES IT?

Animal By-Products are predominantly produced by butchers and slaughter houses, catering from airliners, food items seized by port authorities, freight, zoos, retailers, restaurants, kitchens, and research institutions.



HOW WE MANAGE IT

Specialists in the management of all types of ABPs, Novus Environmental can help you by providing a complete solution. Our national infrastructure of Category 1 approved sites means that we can effectively collect Animal By-Products on an ad-hoc or scheduled basis for hygienic disposal or processing.

Our on-site incineration plants meet strict regulations enforced by APHA and DEFRA, which ensures that your Category 1 waste is dealt with compliantly. Where ABPs are classified as Category 3, we can offer the benefit of 'green' treatment in approved anaerobic digestion or biogas facilities.

PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE

WHAT IS PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE?

Pharmaceutical wastes are wastes derived from medicines and drugs used in the treatment of humans and animals, including medicines, packaging contaminated with medicine, and items used to handle or administer medicines.

Prescription Only drugs (18 01 08*) are prescribed medicines regulated by the Medicines Act 1968. Some prescription medicines contain drugs that are controlled under the Misuse of Drugs legislation. These medicines are called Controlled Drugs and include Morphine and Methadone. This category also includes cytotoxic and cytostatic drugs prescribed and administered in the treatment of cancer.

Over-the-Counter medicines (18 01 09) are sold without the need for a prescription. They include low dosage pain killers, dietary supplements, herbal remedies, and hay fever medicine.

Research and Development drugs are medicines produced or used in limited quantities by research and biotechnology companies, which are not publicly marketed.

HOW WE MANAGE IT

We collect and dispose of expired, partly used, or unused drugs from Government Schemes and pharmaceutical institutions, with no minimum or maximum restriction on volumes. We are also licensed by the Home Office under the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971.

Our comprehensive service assists you in meeting your responsibilities under the Waste Framework Directive (2006/12/EC). From UN approved consumables to Waste Transfer Note paperwork.



CLINICAL & SHARPS WASTE WE PROVIDE COMPLETE DESTRUCTION, **CONORMING TO RIGOROUS ENVIRONMENTAL AGENCY REQUIREMENTS**

WHAT IS CLINICAL & SHARPS WASTE?

Clinical and sharps waste consist of materials and instruments that are used in medical procedures, in both public and private organisations.

Clinical (Infectious) waste includes surgical dressings, swabs, gloves, gowns, clothing or other similar soft items which may be contaminated with blood, bodily fluids or excretions. It may also contain human or animal tissue from surgical procedures or biopsies.

Sharps waste (contaminated with medicines) includes hypodermic needles, syringes, and other sharp instruments, which are contaminated with medicines.

Sharps waste (not contaminated with medicines) includes hypodermic needles, scalpel blades, knives, syringes, bone pins and other sharp instruments that have been used in the practice of phlebotomy and obtaining blood.

WHO PRODUCES IT?

Most clinical & sharps waste is produced by the healthcare sector, and includes hospitals, GP surgeries, dental practices, nursing homes, zoological institutes, the veterinary industry, and research institutes.

HOW WE MANAGE IT

The correct segregation of your clinical and sharps waste demonstrates strong health and safety governance. Clinical waste is shredded and then sterilised in our rotoclaves. The resulting flock is used to create solid reclaimed fuel (SRF) or refuse derived fuel (RDF), which used to generate energy from waste.

To support this, we can provide best practice training and guidance, along with a range of effective sharps containers. This helps minimise the risk of needle-stick injuries to staff and others.

SEIZED GOODS DISPOSAL

TYPES OF SEIZED GOODS

Seized goods are segregated into three categories, determining how they are handled:

Counterfeit goods are items that imitate branded goods and are generally manufactured to inferior quality. Most fraudulent goods are produced overseas and are typically seized at ports, airports and market stalls.

Contaminated goods are items contaminated with a substance that poses a danger to human and animal health or the environment.

Confiscated goods are objects that have been seized because they do not have the necessary paperwork, are out of date or rotten, are deemed to be a dangerous or illegal trade, or prohibited from being imported into the UK.




HOW WE MANAGE IT

We identify the most appropriate disposal method. For example, clothing can be shredded and used to create new textiles.

Our secure service assures that seized items are permanently removed from the marketplace, which helps to protect companies' reputations and their brands. Our staff have Home Office Counter Terrorist Checks (CTC) Clearance. We can also arrange for an observer to witness the destruction of seized goods for peace of mind or legal purposes.

We work closely with the Trading Standards, Environmental Health and DEFRA to ensure that seized goods are effectively managed, protecting consumers and the environment.
